



Regulation of La Verticale de la Tour Eiffel 2020

Any registration to La Verticale of the Eiffel® Tower of the EcoTrail Paris Ile-de-France® 2020 implies the tacit acceptance of the following rules:

1 EVENT

The Vertical of the Eiffel Tower® is a timed race whose objective is the complete ascent of the first 2 levels of the Eiffel Tower, i.e. 665 steps to climb for a positive altitude difference of 116 meters.

The event will take place on Wednesday, March 11, 2020 between 8:10 pm and 10:20 pm in 3 stages:

- 1st qualifying round
- 2nd qualifying round
- Final

Pour qualifications:

Each participant will start individually in the manner of a time trial according to an order established by the organization.

The times of the first and second rounds are combined to establish a reference ranking, the basis for qualification for the final.

For the final:

At the end of the qualifying round, the top 10 women and 20 men will be able to compete in the final.

The final will be held in the pursuit format. The athlete with the best cumulative time in the 2 qualifying heats will start first with the lead over the second, and so on.

2 PARTICIPATION

The Vertical of the Eiffel Tower® has 131 participants distributed as follows:

- 40 elite runners from the world of running (ascent races, "vertical km" Trail, Trail, road race, track race...) => designated in the Hat A regulation
- 81 runners drawn at random at the close of the pre-registration for the race => designated in the Hat B rules
- 10 runners selected directly by the organization in the form of wildcard => designated in the Hat C rules



The 40 elite runners (hat A) will be selected by a committee of experts, following their pre-registration. The date of appointment of the runners of hat A is fixed at 17 December 2019.

Pre-registration at La Verticale de la Tour Eiffel® for the 81 runners drawn at random (hat B) is open under conditions (see conditions for registration at La Verticale de la Tour Eiffel® - Hat B) to any person, man or woman, born in 2000 or earlier (U23 to veterans' categories), licensed or not.

3.1 CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION TO LA VERTICALE OF THE EIFFEL® TOWER - HAT A

For the 40 elite runners from hat A, 2 conditions must be met in order to participate in the selection of the committee of experts:

- Be pre-registered for the Vertical of the Eiffel Tower®.
- Fulfill certain performance requirements / past races (see chapter 4)

Runners from hat A not selected by the committee of experts will automatically be transferred to hat B.

3.2 CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION TO LA VERTICALE OF THE EIFFEL® TOWER - HAT B

For the 81 runners from hat B, 2 steps are necessary and inseparable for the validation of a registration to La Verticale of the Eiffel Tower®:

- Pre-registration followed by a draw
- The final registration

3.2.1 PRE-REGISTRATION AND RANDOM DRAW

2 conditions must be met in order to participate in the draw for La Verticale de la tour Eiffel®:

- Be pre-registered at La Verticale de la tour Eiffel®.
- Fulfill certain performance requirements / past races (see chapter 4)

3.2.2 DEFINITIVE REGISTRATION FOLLOWING THE FAVOURABLE DRAW

The draw for the 81 pre-registered runners in hat B will take place on 19 December 2019 following the validation of the pre-registrations.

Participants drawn by lot following pre-registration have a period between 19 December (following the official announcement of the draws) and 31 January 2020 at 11:59 am, in order to confirm their registration for the Eiffel Tower Vertical on their online member account (<http://verticaletou Eiffel.runforyou.fr/>)

The copy of the licence (FFA, FSCF, FSGT, UFOLEP) 2019-2020 or a medical certificate with the mention "No contraindication to competitive sport" dating from less than one year (therefore after 11 March 2019) is required for final validation of the registration (see Chapter 7).

3.3 CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION TO LA VERTICALE OF THE EIFFEL® TOWER - HAT C

For the 10 runners selected directly by the organization, 2 steps are necessary and inseparable for the validation of a registration to La Verticale of the Eiffel Tower®:

- Be pre-registered for the Vertical of the Eiffel Tower®.



- Fulfill certain performance requirements / past races (see chapter 4)

4 PERFORMANCE CONDITIONS / PAST RACES

In order to be able to participate in La Verticale de la tour Eiffel®, it is necessary to complete at least the following timing performances on 1 official race within a period of 2 years before December 6, 2019 at 11:59 am:

Stair races:

Anyone finishing a stair race of at least 700 steps has the possibility to pre-register

Climbing races:

- Km Vertical : Finisher

Road races:

- 10 km: Time strictly less than 50 min (12.0 km/h)

- 20 km: Time strictly less than 1h49min (11.0 km/h)

- 21.1 km: Time strictly less than 1h54min (11.0 km/h)

- 42.2 km: Time strictly less than 4h13min (10.0 km/h)

Trails :

Anyone finishing a Trail with a minimum distance of 45 km has the possibility to pre-register.

Any performance must be justified by a diploma or official result of the test carried out issued by the competent organisation.

The runner must ensure that he appears in the document provided at the time of pre-registration and that his NAME and First Name are spelled correctly.

In the event of an inaccurate, non-compliant or misleading declaration, the organisation reserves the right to cancel the runner's pre-registration without refund of the entry fee.

5 ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATIONS

Participation to La Verticale of the Eiffel Tower® implies de facto unconditional acceptance of these rules.

6 MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS VERTICALLY FROM THE EIFFEL® TOWER

131 participants

7 REGISTRATION

Pre-registrations and final registrations are only made online from the La Verticale de la tour Eiffel® website: verticaletoureiffel.fr

Commitment period: from October 3, 2019 to December 6, 2019 at 11:59 am

Commitment rights: Pre-registration: 10€¹⁾ / person

(1) In the event of a favourable draw, the participant will be informed by email and must definitively validate his registration no later than 31 January 2020 at 11:59 am by paying an additional 50€.

In the event of an unfavourable draw, all the entry fees deducted from the registration fees (1 euro) will be transferred to a charitable association. (Les Bonnes Fées - www.lesbonnesfees.fr) and will not entitle you to a refund.

Payments are made online from a secure banking platform.

To finalize their registration, each participant must MUST join online (at the time of final registration) or deposit on their member account (possible until January 31, 2020)

- Either his medical certificate dated less than one year before the day of the race (or after 11/03/2019)
- Either a copy of his certificate of licence (FFA) 2019-2020
- Either a copy of its license (FSCF, FSGT, UFOLEP) 2019-2020

In order to facilitate your task and avoid any dispute during its validation, we suggest you download a model medical certificate (which you can use again on other races):

MANDATORY

No other licence or certificate of licence will be accepted after January 31, 2020. Once this document has been validated by the organization, a confirmation email will be sent to confirm the final registration.

Once the date of 31 January 2020 has passed or without acknowledgement of receipt of the document in question, the registration will be cancelled and will not give rise to any refund of commitment fees.

To be valid, the medical certificate must include the mention of "no contraindication to the practice of competitive sport" or "no contraindication to the practice of running in competition".

Any incomplete application form will be rejected. The commitment fees include all the services described in these regulations. An acknowledgement of receipt is sent by email, and confirmation of registrations can also be made on the race website.

8 CANCELLATION OF A REGISTRATION TO LA VERTICALE DE LA TOUR EIFFEL®

In the case of cancellation, all the commitment fees for pre-registration (€10) and/or final registration (€60) deducted from the application fee will be paid to a charity defined later and will in no case give rise to a refund.

9 EQUIPMENT FOR THE VERTICAL OF THE EIFFEL® TOWER

Mandatory equipment provided by the organization:

- Chasuble,
- Bib number,
- Chip for timing,
- Bracelet.



Equipment to be provided by the runner:

- Running shirt,
- Shorts or tights,
- A pair of running shoes,
- Pair of gloves (very strongly recommended for hanging on the stairs railing).

In order to avoid falling objects during the ascent of the Eiffel Tower, the organization prohibits any other object or equipment than those mentioned above (Telephone, camera, camera are strictly prohibited).

A check of the equipment will be carried out just before the start of each runner.

10 CHASUBLES, BIBS AND BRACELETS

A chasuble, a bib and a bracelet will be given to participants upon presentation of an identity document.

The bibs will be collected under the tent located in the Emile Anthoine Sports Centre on Wednesday 11 March 2020 between 18:00 and 19:30.

The chasuble, bib and bracelet must be kept for the duration of the race. They are used as passes at the entrance to the South Pillar of the Eiffel Tower and for post-race refuelling.

The bib must be visible at all times and in full throughout the race. It must therefore always be positioned above any clothing. The name and logo of the partners must not be modified or hidden.

11 RUNNER BRIEFING

A briefing setting out the race and safety instructions will be organised on **Wednesday 11 March 2020 at 7.30pm** at the Emile Anthoine Stadium (same place as the handing over of the chasuble, bib and chip).

The presence of all runners is mandatory.

12 CHIPS FOR TIMING

When the bibs are handed out, an electronic chip is given individually to each runner to allow timekeeping. This must be placed as stipulated in the technical instructions. Each runner is responsible for the proper use of the chip. The runner may not be timed in the following cases:

- not wearing the chip,
- lose of the puce,
- chip degradation,
- wearing the non-compliant chip.

13 RUNNER BAGS FOR THE FINISH LINE

Each competitor brings his own 30-litre bag for personal use (change of clothes, toiletries...). A self-adhesive label placed in the race number envelope must be affixed to the bag.



- After completing it with the items of his choice and closing it, he can drop it off between 6:00 p.m. and 7:45 p.m. on Wednesday, March 11, 2020 at the Centre Sportif Emile Anthoine in the place provided for this purpose. No runner bags will be accepted by the organization outside these hours.
- The bags are collected at the same place as the drop-off. The bags are given either to the competitor or to relatives, only on presentation of the chasuble with bib and the bracelet or identity card. The bags are handed over until midnight on the same day. Beyond this time, the runner must pick up his bag himself, at his own expense, from the organization, at 33 rue Général Leclerc in Issy-les-Moulineaux (92130).
- All bags must be collected from the organisation within a maximum of 15 days after the event, after which time the contents will be donated to charitable organisations.

14 SAFETY AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Medical teams will be present at the following 34 areas along the route: square, 1st floor platform, and 2nd floor platform, intermediate platform and top of the Eiffel Tower. The 24 first aid stations are intended to assist any person in danger with the organisation's own resources or under contract.

First aiders will also be present on intermediate levels throughout the route.

A rescue team (pair) will be positioned on Wednesday, March 11, 2020 from 7:30 pm to 10:30 pm in the Gustave Eiffel room.

Physicians are entitled to remove from the test any person who is unable to continue the test. First-aid workers are entitled to evacuate by any means at their convenience persons they consider to be in danger.

If necessary, for reasons that are always in the interest of the rescued person, the fire brigade will be called in. At that time, the Operations Department will use all appropriate means. The costs resulting from the use of these exceptional means shall be borne by the rescued person, who shall also ensure his return from the point where he has been evacuated. She will then be able to submit a file to her personal accident insurance.

Any participant calling upon a doctor or first-aid attendant submits de facto to his authority and undertakes to accept his decisions.

15 TIMING STATION AND REFUELLING AREAS

Timing stations are set up at several points along the route: South departure pillar, 1st floor platform and, 2nd floor platform, intermediate platform and top of the Eiffel Tower.

Only runners wearing a visible bib number have access to the water point area. The water point area is located at the top of level 2. A refreshment and an after-race snack in the form of a buffet are served at the Emile Anthoine Gymnasium to all participants to La Verticale de la tour Eiffel®.

16 TIME BARRIERS

In order to guarantee the safety of the runners, time barriers established on the total ascent time are set up by the organisation:

Level 1 (330 steps): 8 minutes

Any runner who is out of the race will not be able to continue his course and will have to go down to the Eiffel Tower Square following the instructions of the organisation.



17 SHOWERS

It is possible for participants of La Verticale de la tour Eiffel® to take a shower in Paris at the Emile Anthoine sports centre.

18 ABANDONMENT AND REPATRIATION

A participant wishing to withdraw can keep his bib, which will allow him to enter the Emile Anthoine Sports Centre in order to obtain access to the buffet.

The repatriation to the square must be done by the elevators and must be done with respect for the other participants always in the race by following the instructions of the organization.

19 PROCEDURE IN CASE OF NEUTRALISATION OF THE STROKE

In the case of an incident during the ascent of the Eiffel Tower, Race HQ will take the decision to neutralize the race and will inform all members of the organization present throughout the course.

The runners engaged in the stairs will be stopped by the members of the organization at the timing mat and await instructions from Race HQ.

When the incident is over, the race will be restarted simultaneously on the timing mats located on each platform.

The maximum cumulative time of the various stops may not exceed 1 hour. As soon as this time has been accumulated, the organisation will take the decision to stop the race and inform the runners. The latter will then have to return to the Gustave Eiffel room following the organisation's instructions.

20 PENALISATION - DISQUALIFICATION

Starts will be given in the manner of a time trial according to an order established by the organisation and will be communicated to the runners at the time of the withdrawal of their race number. **A participant absent from the departure schedule indicated to him/her will automatically be disqualified and will not be entitled to leave at a different schedule than the one initially established.**

Controllers on the course are authorised to check the compulsory equipment, the good performance of the race and, more generally, compliance with the rules (Good visibility of the race number, etc...) **It is strictly forbidden to come into physical contact, in any way, with any other competitor on the entire course. The doubling of any other competitor must only be done from the outside. Any failure to comply with these rules will be reported to Race HQ, which will be the sole judge of the penalty to be imposed on the runner (time penalty: 5 minutes per illegal overrun / disqualification).**

Any runner who is not in possession, during a control on the course, of all his mandatory equipment will be immediately disqualified, without any possibility of appealing against this decision.

The display or exhibition of brands, sponsors or partners outside the race venue is strictly prohibited within the Eiffel Tower, and the organiser is responsible for ensuring that this rule is respected. Failure to comply with it will result in immediate and irremediable disqualification. In addition, the competitor concerned may not claim to register for future editions of La Verticale de la tour Eiffel® or those of the EcoTrail de Paris Ile de France®.

The event jury may disqualify a competitor for any serious breach of the rules, in particular in the event of:

- Wearing the non-compliant bib,



- Not wearing the bracelet,
- Failure to comply with the instructions given by the control room,
- Failure to assist a competitor in difficulty,
- Display and exhibition, in any form, of brands, sponsors or partners, within the Eiffel Tower,
- Carrying equipment or objects: ex: camera, telephone, camera,....

21 RECLAMATIONS

They shall be admissible in writing within 15 minutes of the posting of the provisional results.

22 ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Any competitor may be subjected to an anti-doping test upon arrival of La Verticale from the Eiffel Tower®. Refusal to submit to it results in immediate disqualification. Any positive control will result in lifelong exclusion from the events organised by SAS Eco-Trail Organisation.

23 JURY OF THE EVENT

It is composed of:

- of the organizer,
- of the race director,
- the coordinator responsible for safety,
- of the head of the medical team,
- the persons in charge of the control areas concerned,
- as well as any competent person at the discretion of the President of the Organising Committee. The jury is authorised to rule within the time limit compatible with the requirements of the race on all disputes or disqualifications that have arisen during the race. Decisions are final.

24 MODIFICATIONS OF THE COURSE / CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT

The organization reserves the right to modify the course at any time, without notice.

In the event of bad weather conditions, and for safety reasons, the organisation reserves the right to cancel and/or stop the current race, or even to modify the event schedule. Departures may be postponed by a maximum of two hours, after which they will be cancelled.

Cancellation, postponement or modification of the race does not entitle you to any refund of registration fees.

Any decision will be taken by a jury comprising at least the race manager, the organiser and the coordinator responsible for safety as well as any competent person at the discretion of the President of the Organising Committee.

25 INSURANCE



Civil liability: The organiser takes out civil liability insurance for the duration of the events. This civil liability insurance covers the financial consequences of its liability, that of its employees and participants.

Individual accident: Each participant must have an individual accident insurance policy. Such insurance may be taken out with any organisation of the participant's choice, and in particular with the French Athletics Federation : <http://www.athle.fr/>

26 RANKINGS AND AWARDS

A trophy ceremony will be held in the Gustave Eiffel lounge to reward the 3 best times (men's and women's rankings). A "Finisher" gift will be given to each participant who arrives at the top of the Eiffel Tower, a buffet will be available to participants at the Emile Anthoine Stadium (bib handover area).

27 SUPPORT

The Vertical of the Eiffel Tower® is an incentive to the practice of sport initiated as part of the values of solidarity of the EcoTrail de Paris Ile de France®, it seemed natural to the organization to associate associations working for the same causes.

As a result, it was decided that the organisation would donate all the sums from the pre-registrations of people who had not been drawn at random to a charity (after deduction of the registration fee: 1 euro).

28 IMAGE RIGHTS

By participating in La Verticale de la tour Eiffel®, each participant expressly authorises SAS EcoTrail Organisation (or its successors in title) to use or have used or have used or have reproduced his name, image, voice and sporting performance as part of La Verticale de la tour Eiffel® for any direct use or in a form derived from the event, on any medium, worldwide, by all known or unknown means to date, and for the entire term of protection currently granted to such direct or derived operations by legislative or regulatory provisions, judicial and/or arbitral decisions of any country and by current or future international conventions, including any extensions that may be made to that term.

29 PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION is involved in the protection of personal data and undertakes to ensure the security and confidentiality of personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter "DGPS"), in particular by taking all necessary precautions to prevent such data from being distorted, damaged or accessed by unauthorized third parties.

When registering for a sporting event organised by ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION, the client is informed and accepts that his personal data may be:

- (i) collected on the www.traildeparis.runforyou.fr web site, owned by RUN FOR YOU and mandated by ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION;
- (ii) used by ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION which acts as controller within the meaning of the RGPD and by RUN FOR YOU, its subcontractor.



29.1 Identity of the data controller

29.2 Data and information collected

The data collected are:

① Data required for registration for the sporting event organised by ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION:

When you register, you are asked to provide mandatory data identified on the site by an asterisk: name, first names, date of birth, gender, nationality, e-mail address, mobile phone, postal address, language, information relating to the person to be notified in the event of a racing incident (name, first name, telephone), jersey size, medical certificate for fitness for competition.

This list is subject to change according to the legal, technical or organisational constraints of ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION.

② Optional data :

When you register, other data is requested but is not essential for your registration (name of the member club, fixed telephone, etc.).

In addition, we or RUN FOR YOU may send you, after the sporting event, one or more satisfaction surveys and collect, on this occasion, additional data, such as: level of sporting activity, consumption habits, socio-professional category, leisure, participation in events, materials and equipment used, etc.

③ Payment data :

During registration, our payment service provider collects and processes data concerning your means of payment (credit card number, expiry date of the credit card, visual cryptogram (not kept), etc). The details of your payment method communicated at the time of registration are encrypted using a security protocol and are never transmitted in clear text over the network. The data concerning your means of payment are not communicated to us by the banking service provider.

④ Technical data :

We may collect technical data such as connection data, IP address in accordance with applicable legislation, and if applicable with your consent, for the use of certain technologies such as Cookies.



No sensitive data are collected, namely information concerning racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, philosophical or religious beliefs, trade union membership, etc. (art. 9 of the GDR).

29.3 Purposes of the processing operation

ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION uses and exploits your personal data for the following purposes:

- management and validation of registrations for sports events organised by ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION,
- management of the information relationship with the participant by email and/or SMS concerning the event for which he/she has registered (confirmation of the correct consideration of the registration, confirmation of the validation or refusal of the registration, information on the sporting event, information on the results, etc).

RUN FOR YOU uses and exploits your personal data for the following purposes:

- sending satisfaction surveys for scientific and statistical purposes (by means of surveys or questionnaires);
- statistical studies;
- information relating to the offers and activities of ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION and other forms of related services;
- sending emails or SMS messages to inform you about sporting events that may be of interest to you organised by ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION or a third party organiser;
- shares data with our privileged partners (industry, media, institutions) for the purpose of communicating promotional offers, advertisements and other commercial communications (subject to your prior consent where required and respect for your right to object, in accordance with applicable commercial prospecting rules).

29.4 Data retention

Your data will be kept for as long as necessary for the purposes set out above. Your data will be deleted if you do not respond to any of our requests for three years. However, we may retain your data for a longer period of time in order to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations or to resolve disputes.

29.5 The recipients of the data

The personal data collected during your online registration may be communicated:

- ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION's internal services (administrative staff, employees and attendants); to ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION's privileged partners (industrial, media, institutional), with your agreement, in order to offer products and/or services or for the purposes of commercial prospecting and/or advertising communications.

ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION asks its service providers and partners to implement strict confidentiality and data mining measures.

If you have expressly consented to this when you register by ticking the box provided for this purpose, you may receive promotional offers by telephone and/or post or by email or SMS from our business



partners to whom your data may be transmitted and transferred for the purpose of commercial prospecting. In any case, you may at any time object to it under the conditions set out below.

By choosing to participate in the sporting event, participants acknowledge and accept that:

- their full name and surname(s) appear on the official starting list published on the Ecotrail.com website;
- at the end of the sporting event, information related to their sporting performance (in particular, results, photos and videos) is published on the Ecotrail.com website; the said results may be used by any media.

If you wish to oppose such publication for a legitimate reason, you must communicate this decision, in writing, to our subcontractor at the following address: RUN FOR YOU - Processing of personal data by ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION -33 rue du général Leclerc - 92130 Issy les Moulineaux, at the latest one month before the sporting event so that appropriate measures can be taken.

Except in the cases set out above, ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION undertakes not to sell, rent, transfer or give access to third parties to your collected data without your prior consent, unless it is required to do so for a legitimate reason (legal obligation, fight against fraud or abuse, exercise of the rights of the defence, etc.).

Some of the recipients mentioned above may be located outside the European Union and may have access to all or part of the personal information collected by ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION.

You expressly agree that your data may be transmitted to service providers or partners located outside the European Union.

In this context, ECOTRAIL ORGANISATION undertakes to guarantee the protection of your data in accordance with the strictest rules, in particular through the signature, on a case-by-case basis, of contractual clauses based on the European Commission's model, or any other mechanism in accordance with the DGPS, as soon as your personal data are processed by a service provider outside the European Economic Area and whose country is not considered by the European Commission as ensuring an adequate level of protection.

29.6 Commercial offers

ECOTRAIL ORGANIZATION and its subcontractor RUN FOR YOU may send you, by mail, email, sms, telephone, information relating to their offers and services similar to those you have purchased, which you acknowledge and accept.
